When they had seen Him, they made widely known the word which was told them concerning this Child.


¹⁸ And all those who heard it marveled at what the shepherds told them.

¹⁴ The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, the glory as the only Son of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Matthew 2:1-12 (MEV) The Visit of the Wise Men

2 Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, wise men came from the east to Jerusalem, ² saying, "Where is He who was born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the east and have come to worship Him."

³When Herod the king heard these things, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. ⁴And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he inquired of them where Christ should be born. ⁵They told him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for this is what the prophet wrote:

⁶ 'And you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are no longer least among the princes of Judah; for out of you shall come a Governor, who will shepherd My people Israel."

⁷ Then Herod, when he had privately called the wise men, carefully inquired of them what time the star appeared. ⁸ And he sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search diligently for the young Child, and when you have found Him, bring me word again, so that I may come and worship Him also."

⁹When they heard the king, they departed. And the star which they saw in the east went before them until it came and stood over where the young Child was.

The Birth of Jesus Christ

¹⁸ Now the birth of Jesus Christ happened this way: After His mother Mary was engaged to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child by the Holy Spirit.

Then Joseph her husband, being a just man and not willing to make her a public example, had in mind to divorce her privately.

²⁰ But while he thought on these things, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife, for He who is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit.

²¹ She will bear a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins."

²² Now all this occurred to fulfill what the Lord had spoken through the prophet, saying,

²³ "A virgin shall be with child, and will bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is interpreted, "God with us."

²⁴ Then Joseph, being awakened from sleep, did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him, and remained with his wife.
