Compared to the other plants in the garden, this seems astounding.


Whilst other plants are dying for lack of water, these lilies are bursting with health and vigor - yet they have not been watered.

⁶He did not say this because he cared about the poor but because he was a thief; as keeper of the money bag, he used to help himself to what was put into it.


