Recently I was waiting in the car. There was a truck parked nearby.

A crow landed on the side of the truck, and then went foraging in the tray of the truck. After a few moments the crow reappeared on the side of the tray. The bird could barely hold a massive piece of food in its beak. It was struggling to know how to tackle it. Then another crow landed beside the first crow. It had something guite small in its beak possibly only a leaf.

After the second bird landed, it dropped its' "cargo" onto the ground. The first bird then also dropped its find. Both birds flew to the ground and disappeared from view. One soon reappeared - this time with a manageable-sized piece of food which it was able to break up and swallow.

It was interesting to watch the behaviour of these birds - one hoping to keep its find to itself, but unable to resist the temptation to grab even more. The other bird was able to outwit the first bird and to gain a share of the spoils.

How different to the behaviour shown by the Good Samaritan, who was ready to reach out and help another, with no thought of his own gain, or of the risk he was taking in stopping to help the man he helped.


