Jeremiah's Letter to the Exiles

29 Now these are the words of the letter that Jeremiah the prophet sent from Jerusalem to the rest of the elders of the captivity, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the people whom Nebuchadnezzar had carried away captive from Jerusalem to Babylon.

⁴ Thus says the LORD of Hosts, the God of Israel, to all who have been carried away captive whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem to Babylon: ⁵ Build houses and dwell in them; and plant gardens and eat their fruit. ⁶ Take wives and beget sons and daughters; and take wives for your sons and give your daughters to husbands, so that they may bear sons and daughters; so that you may increase there and not diminish. ⁷ Seek the peace of the city where I have caused you to be carried away captive, and pray to the LORD for it; for in its peace you will have peace.

2 Timothy 2:8-15 (MEV)

⁸ Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David, according to my gospel, ⁹ in which I suffer trouble like a criminal, even with chains. But the word of God is not bound. ¹⁰ Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

¹¹ This is a faithful saying:

If we die with Him, we shall also live with Him.

¹² If we endure, we shall also reign with Him.

If we deny Him,

He also will deny us.

13 If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.

¹⁴ Remind them of these things, commanding them before the Lord that they not argue about words, which leads to nothing of value and to the destruction of those who hear them. ¹⁵ Study to show yourself approved by God, a workman who need not be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

¹⁸Were there not any found to return and give glory to God except this foreigner?"


Then He said to him, "Rise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."
