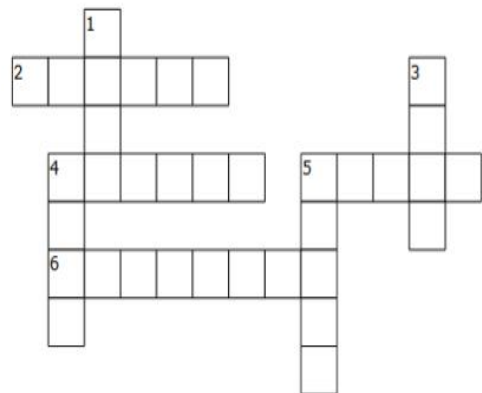
The Great Commission
