Perhaps we need to look beyond the symbols, and to be aware of the presence of the Holy Spirit in all its forms.


When we "tap into" that presence, it has the potential to energise us, fill us and empower us.

⁶ Rather, you are filled with grief because I have said these things.

⁷ But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

⁸When he comes, he will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment: ⁹about sin, because people do not believe in me;
