### Jeremiah 29:1, 4-7 (NIV)

A Letter to the Exiles

**29** This is the text of the letter that the prophet Jeremiah sent from Jerusalem to the surviving elders among the exiles and to the priests, the prophets and all the other people Nebuchadnezzar had carried into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon.

<sup>4</sup>This is what the LORD Almighty, the God of Israel, says to all those I carried into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon:

<sup>5</sup> "Build houses and settle down; plant gardens and eat what they produce.

<sup>6</sup> Marry and have sons and daughters: find wives for your sons and give your daughters in marriage, so that they too may have sons and daughters. Increase in number there; do not decrease.

<sup>7</sup> Also. seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the LORD for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper."

#### Psalm 66:1-12 (NIV)

Shout for joy to God, all the earth!

<sup>2</sup> Sing the glory of his name; make his praise glorious.

<sup>3</sup> Say to God, "How awesome are your deeds! So great is your power that your enemies cringe before you.

<sup>4</sup> All the earth bows down to you; they sing praise to you,

they sing the praises of your name."

<sup>5</sup> Come and see what God has done, his awesome deeds for mankind!

<sup>6</sup> He turned the sea into dry land, they passed through the waters on foot come, let us rejoice in him.

<sup>7</sup>He rules forever by his power, his eves watch the nationslet not the rebellious rise up against him.

<sup>8</sup> Praise our God, all peoples, let the sound of his praise be heard:

<sup>9</sup> he has preserved our lives and kept our feet from slipping.

<sup>10</sup> For you, God, tested us;

you refined us like silver.

11 You brought us into prison and laid burdens on our backs.

<sup>12</sup> You let people ride over our heads; we went through fire and water, but you brought us to a place of abundance.

But the love which we show to others may be the only way they have of understanding God's love for them.


So let's continue to share God's love wherever we go. Blessings from Meg
