  The LORD is the stronghold of my life— of whom shall I be afraid?
- When the wicked advance against me to devour me, it is my enemies and my foes who will stumble and fall.
- Though an army besiege me, my heart will not fear; though war break out against me, even then I will be confident.
- One thing I ask from the LORD, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple.
- For in the day of trouble he will keep me safe in his dwelling; he will hide me in the shelter of his sacred tent and set me high upon a rock.

<sup>33</sup> In any case, I must press on today and tomorrow and the next day—for surely no prophet can die outside Jerusalem!


