## John 10:1-10 (NLT)

## The Good Shepherd and His Sheep

**10** "I tell you the truth, anyone who sneaks over the wall of a sheepfold, rather than going through the gate, must surely be a thief and a robber!

<sup>2</sup> But the one who enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep.



<sup>3</sup> The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep recognize his voice and come to him. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.

<sup>4</sup> After he has gathered his own flock, he walks ahead of them, and they follow him because they know his voice.

<sup>5</sup> They won't follow a stranger; they will run from him because they don't know his voice."

<sup>6</sup> Those who heard Jesus use this illustration didn't understand what he meant, <sup>7</sup> so he explained it to them: "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep.

<sup>8</sup> All who came before me were thieves and robbers. But the true sheep did not listen to them.

<sup>9</sup> Yes, I am the gate. Those who come in through me will be saved. They will come and go freely and will find good pastures.

<sup>10</sup> The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life.




## Psalm 23 (NLT)

## IN OUR PRAYERS


- We pray for our members who have had colds recently, and hope that they recover quickly.
