Parable of the Ten Bridesmaids

25 "Then the Kingdom of Heaven will be like ten bridesmaids who took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom.

² Five of them were foolish, and five were wise.

³ The five who were foolish didn't take enough olive oil for their lamps, ⁴ but the other five were wise enough to take along extra oil.

⁵ When the bridegroom was delayed, they all became drowsy and fell asleep.

⁶ "At midnight they were roused by the shout, 'Look, the bridegroom is coming! Come out and meet him!'

⁷ "All the bridesmaids got up and prepared their lamps.

⁸ Then the five foolish ones asked the others, 'Please give us some of your oil because our lamps are going out.'

⁹ "But the others replied, 'We don't have enough for all of us. Go to a shop and buy some for yourselves.'

¹⁰ "But while they were gone to buy oil, the bridegroom came. Then those who were ready went in with him to the marriage feast, and the door was locked.

¹¹ Later, when the other five bridesmaids returned, they stood outside, calling, 'Lord! Lord! Open the door for us!'

¹² "But he called back, 'Believe me, I don't know you!'

¹³ "So you, too, must keep watch! For you do not know the day or hour of my return.

heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet call of God. First, the believers who have died will rise from their graves.

¹⁷ Then, together with them, we who are still alive and remain on the earth will be caught up in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. Then we will be with the Lord forever.



- We pray for greater wisdom for world leaders.




I heard my mother asking our neighbour for some salt.
