³You have enlarged the nation and increased their joy; they rejoice before you as people rejoice at the harvest, as warriors rejoice when dividing the plunder.


⁴ For as in the day of Midian's defeat, you have shattered the voke that burdens them, the bar across their shoulders, the rod of their oppressor.

- ⁵ And he will be our peace when the Assyrians invade our land and march through our fortresses.


